**DESCRIPTION:** This workshop will address the challenges that children with Attachment disorder present in therapy and at home with parents. There is considerable overlap between interventions helpful in therapy and parenting interventions. As a goodly percentage of these interventions are counterintuitive, therapists typically have to teach them to parents initially and then monitor and refine their use at home over time. A brief overview of attachment disorder, and the diagnostic conundrums that go with it, will be covered. The relationship between attachment disorder and trauma, including the emerging concept of Developmental Trauma Disorder, will be reviewed. The bulk of the workshop will be devoted to

guidelines and interventions for clinical work with this population, intertwined with specialized parenting techniques that attachment disorder requires. A summary view of Attachment Disorder in adults will be included.

**LEARNING OBJECTIVES**

- 2) Explain what makes Attachment Disorder so difficult to diagnose accurately.

- 6) Name three things parents should never do with children with attachment difficulties.
- 7) List the most common diagnostic categories for adults with Attachment Disorder.
